Poitiers, on 24 septembre 2021

Are you an international student or researcher at the University of Poitiers? Are you preparing your PhD in one of the laboratories of the University of Poitiers?

The International Relations Department team is happy to welcome you!

We remind you that if you come from a red or amber list country and you were not able to get vaccinated before your departure, health instructions must be applied before your departure and then on your arrival in France.

If you come from a country on the "amber" list, you must self-isolate for 7 days.

If you come from a country on the "red" list, you must respect a 10-day quarantine.

You must therefore, notify your host of this quarantine and ensure that the accommodation conditions allow you to effectively respect isolation. If you encounter any difficulties, please contact urgently:

The isolation protocol during quarantine involves in particular:

- Stay at home as much as possible by limiting your outings for essential needs within the hours set by the prefectural quarantine decree; in the event of non-compliance with the quarantine measure (absence observed during compulsory attendance hours, etc.), the offender is liable to a fine of € 1,000 increased to € 1,300 after 45 days;
- In the event of cohabitation, avoid contact and wear a mask inside the home;
- Carry out active monitoring of the temperature and the appearance of symptoms of respiratory infection (fever, cough, breathing difficulties, etc.). In case of symptoms, make an appointment immediately with the University Health Service (<https://ssu.univ-poitiers.fr/>).

In addition, upon completion of the isolation period, you may be offered an appointment with a doctor from the University Health Service and you are invited to get vaccinated as soon as possible.

- A vaccination centre is open on the Poitiers campus since **Thursday, September 9.**
