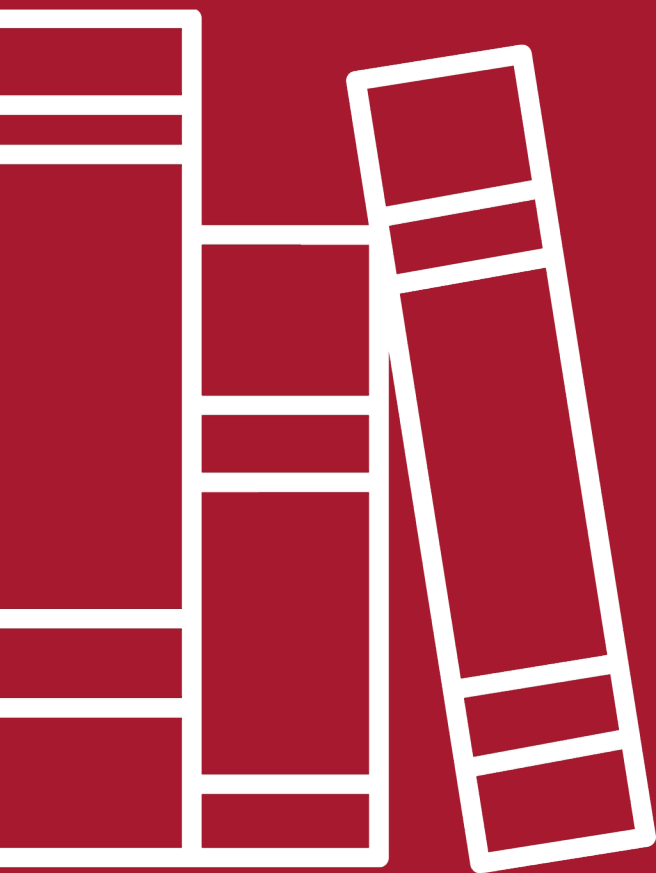

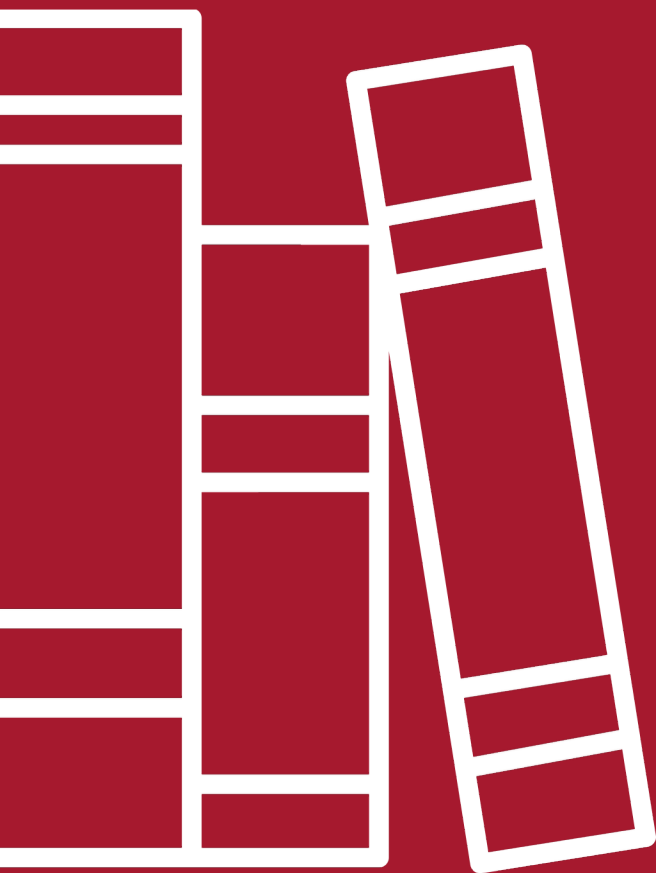

AVANT VOTRE DÉPART / BEFORE LEAVING

List of required documents

- *Your student ID card issued by your home university ;*
- *A letter from your home university authorising you to study in Poitiers ;*
- *Proof of health insurance (European Health Insurance Card for European Union nationals) ;*
- *Documents required for you accommodation.*

APPLY FOR A VISA

Statut / Status	Visa application (VLS)	Procédure / Procedure
EU students-citizens	Non – No	
Students residing in the EU but not EU citizens	Oui – Yes	Student VISA to be requested from the french consulate in the country of residence
Student from outside the EU- EEF programme	Oui – Yes	Automatic application during the registration procedure campusfrance.org
Student from outside the EU- NON EEF programme	Oui – Yes	After receiving the pre-registration certificate: Student visa to be requested from the French Consulate in the country of origin or online.



AVANT VOTRE DÉPART / BEFORE LEAVING

Ce Visa / This VISA

- Is conditional on sufficient resources (amount equivalent to 877,50 € per month);
- Allows the student to enter legally;
- Must be validated **within 3 months** of arrival in France (online : [here](https://www.service-public.fr/particuliers/vosdroits/F16162?lang=en))

AVANT VOTRE DÉPART / BEFORE LEAVING



LOGEMENT / HOUSING :

Exchange students can request a room in CROUS student residences (limited number of rooms!)

- You must have filled the form if you were interested
- Arrival from september 1st (sometimes possible from the 24/08)
- Organize your arrival with the residence (compulsory appointment/online)
- Complete your rental file
- Subscribe **housing insurance**

AVANT VOTRE DÉPART / BEFORE LEAVING



Effective from July 1, 2026, the eligibility requirements for personalized housing assistance (APL) will change for some international students.

This reform applies to foreign students from countries outside:

- *the European Union (EU),*
- *the European Economic Area (EEA),*
- *and Switzerland.*

However, you may still be eligible for APL if you are:

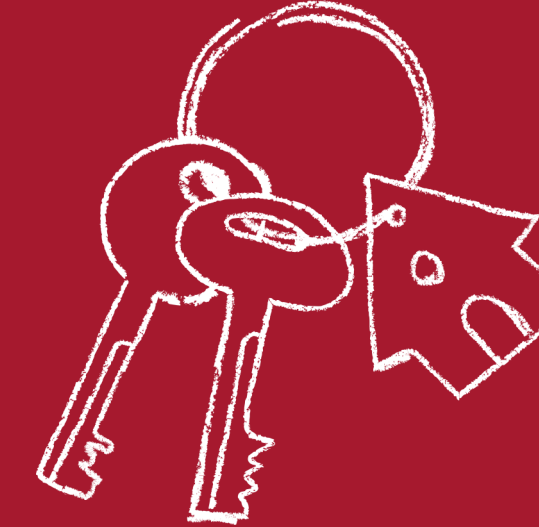
- *a national of a country in the European Union, the EEA, or Switzerland.*
- *a student receiving a need-based scholarship.*
- *an apprentice.*
- *a student who is employed.*

If you wish to apply for APL (Personalized Housing Assistance), the CAF (Family Allowance Fund) can help you determine your eligibility. 32 30 or www.caf.fr

AVANT VOTRE DÉPART / BEFORE LEAVING



You must have a **certificate of home insurance before you can move in**. Several online solutions are available, such as : Etud Assur; SMENO; HEYME (about 30 euros/year)

Guarantor: a person or an organization who agrees to be financially responsible in case you cannot pay your rent

VISALE (free, under 30 YO)

Garantme (30 YO & more)

Help for security deposit

LOCA PASS: interest-free advance for the deposit



QUAND VOUS ÊTES ARRIVÉ.E / UPON ARRIVAL

The easiest way to travel to Poitiers is to fly to **Paris (Charles de Gaulle airport)** and catch the train to Poitiers :

- Directly from the airport : there are several direct trains from the airport to Poitiers (Charles de Gaulle TGV train station)
- From **Gare Montparnasse**: You can also catch a train from the Gare Montparnasse.

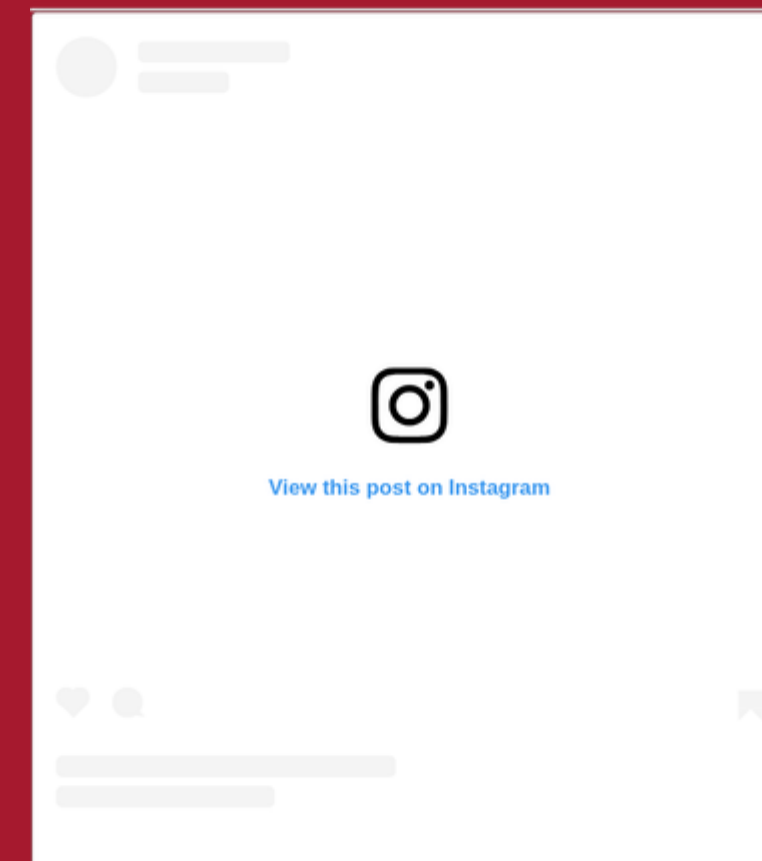

If you cannot enter your accommodation on the day of your arrival you can rent a room at the Youth Hostel "La caserne", located near the train station



QUAND VOUS ÊTES ARRIVÉ.E / UPON ARRIVAL

- *Plan your transportation in Poitiers*
Bus : Vitalis ; Electric bikes : Cap Vélo
- *Meet the welcome team (help, infos..) : if needed, you can ask for an appointment at : accueil.international@univ-poitiers.fr*
- *Meet you faculty coodinator, finalise your administrative registration. Main contact for any questions regarding registration, courses or exams.*
- *For non-Europeans, if it is your first entry into France : Validation of your Long Stay Visa and validating a Residence Permit (VLS-TS) is done online*

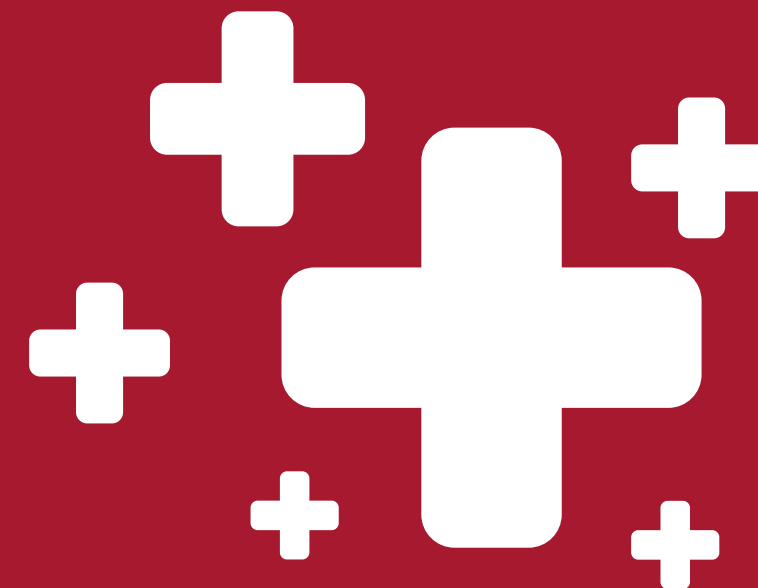


How long does it take to get from your apartment to your faculty (by bike and bus)?



UPON ARRIVAL

Register for Health insurance



- **Students from the European Union**

French social security is not needed (except in special cases). You need the European Health Insurance Card (EHIC), which provides basic coverage and reimburses 70% of medical costs.

Recommendation : subscribe to a complementary coverage, which completes the basic reimbursements up to 25%, sometimes 30% in case of illness or hospitalization.

- **Students from outside the European Union**

Non-European students must register for the social security system or universal health coverage : online, on Ameli

Pre-semester intensive week (September Course)

When : from Monday, August 31, 2026, through Friday, September 4, 2026:

What : Paid course (€220) for exchange students of 25 hours of instruction over one week. Your level will be determined by an online placement test.

Registration deadline: July 20, 2026

A placement test will be administered online before August 26

Where : At the faculty of Lettres et Langues (A3)

When : From Monday, September 14, 2026, to Friday, December 18

- B1 level : Mondays from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.
- B2 level : Tuesdays (to be confirmed) from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.

Cost : 220 euros per semester, but for exchange students, the first 50 to register are eligible for funding that allows them to attend for free.

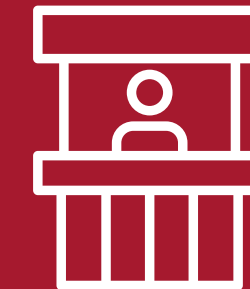
